

Our highlights



Unlimited mental health benefits

This past year, LHSC introduced unlimited mental health benefits for all employees, including union and non-union staff, dependents and retirees, enrolled in our benefits plan. This initiative is part of our commitment to supporting the wellbeing of Team LHSC.



Supportive housing for people experiencing homelessness

LHSC and London Cares Homeless Response Services opened 25 highly supportive housing units for individuals experiencing complex health needs and chronic homelessness to improve health outcomes and reduce hospital readmissions. This work is part of our commitment to supporting London's Health and Homelessness Whole of Community System Response.



Reducing ambulance offload times by 70 per cent

LHSC reduced paramedic wait times for patient transfer to the Emergency Department by 70 per cent, cutting what was previously a two-hour wait to less than 40 minutes. Supported by Ontario's Ministry of Health, key strategies implemented in November 2023 optimized triage and patient flow, enabling faster admissions and freeing up space for new emergencies.
