Specimen Type	Minimum Volume	Collection Kit
Urine (first catch)	2.0 mL	Transfer 2 ml of first catch urine from a sterile container to the Hologic Aptima® Urine Transport tube between the black fill lines using the disposable pipette within 24 hours of
		collection.

Note: the same specimen can be tested for Chlamydia trachomatis NAAT.
