Specimen	Minimum Volume	Collection Device
Drainage	1 mL	Sterile container
Lumbar Puncture	1 mL	LP Tube or sterile container
Tip	2-3 cm of medical device	Sterile container
VP Shunt	1 mL	Sterile container
