

Prostate Cancer Triage

- Patient is within appropriate catchment area (if patient is from Kitchener/Waterloo, Cambridge, Windsor, Owen Sound and Sarnia referring physician should be directed to closest cancer center). Exception: men referred for prostate brachytherapy
- If requirements met patients should be booked into next available radiation oncology consultation slot without radiation oncologist triage required.
- If outstanding items missing note sent back to referring physician to complete.
- If uncertain review referral request with triaging oncologist.

If all criteria present then book in next available consult slot, otherwise return to referring physician to complete indicated investigations/documentation.

PSA result within 3 months must be available for patients referred for a virtual new appointment in all categories

No prior treatment:

Low risk (PSA < 10, Gleason 6 disease):

- Biopsy pathology report must be included
- Staging- not required

Intermediate risk (PSA 10-20 and/or Gleason 7 disease):

- Biopsy pathology report must be included
- Staging- not mandatory.

High risk (PSA > 20 or Gleason 8-10 disease):

- Biopsy pathology report must be included
- CT Scan Abdo/Pelvis Required
- Bone-scan Required

Node positive or distant metastatic disease:

- Biopsy pathology report must be included
- CT Scan Abdo/Pelvis Required
- Bone-scan Required

Post Radical Prostatectomy:

PSA < 10 (PSA within last 6 months):

- Radical prostatectomy pathology- required

PSA > 10 (PSA within last 6 months):

- Radical prostatectomy pathology- required
- Staging – required with Abdo/Pelvis CT and Bone Scan traditional scafor PSMA-PET access through PREP)
