#### **Collection Information:**

This test is available ONLY to patients of London Health Sciences Centre and St. Joseph's Health Care Centre, London and must be approved by a Pathology and Laboratory Medicine Clinical Biochemist. Specimens will NOT be accepted from other organizations for referral.

VIP is not orderable through Powerchart. Patient care areas must fill in a General Laboratory Requisiton once authorization has been obtained from a clinical biochemist. The name of the authorizing clinical biochemist must be indicated on the requisition. Specimens received without the proper authorization will not be processed.

The patient should fast for 10 to 12 hours prior to collection of specimen. Patient should not be on any antacid medications or medications that affect intestinal motility for at least 48 hours prior to collection.

Preferred volume is at least 1 mL plasma, but minimum volume is 550 µL.
