Save Your List

Type up your list and save it in word, as an email (work email) or WordPad (saved to your P drive)

The list should meet the following criteria

- No bullets or indents
- One word (or string of continuous text) per line
- If using a string of text, do not use spaces, underscores or dashes. Start each new word with a capital (no space between). Example:

Troubleshooting

The right hand PC at the CN desk has had Javascript upgraded (required to use Wordle).

If you get a message that says “Javascript is out of date” you should be able to bypass this by choosing the option to the right of the prompt “do you want to upgrade”.

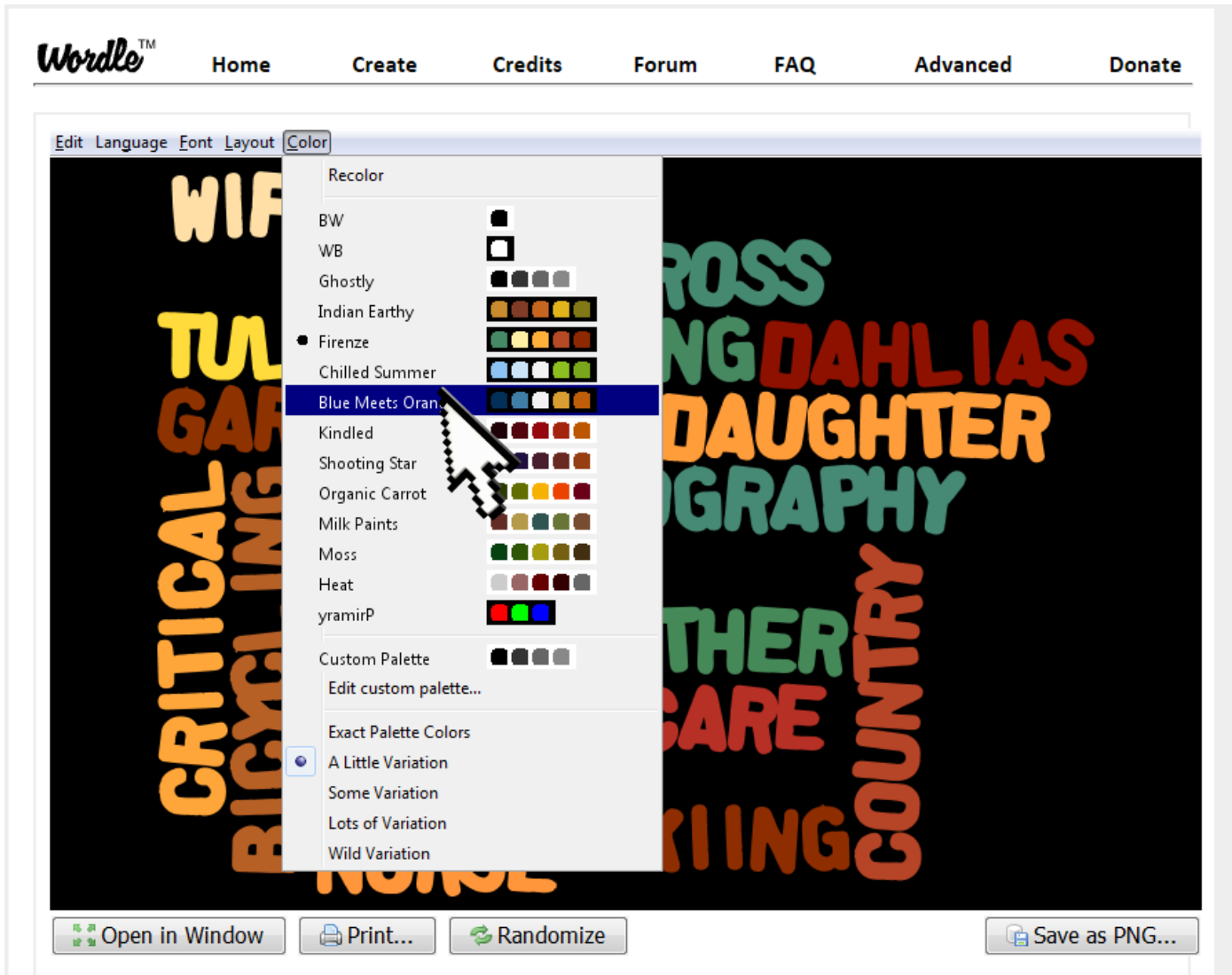
