

MRI Scan Check List

An MRI is a camera at the hospital that takes pictures of your body. It can help doctors see your bones, muscles and organs! There are a few steps to having your pictures taken. They are:

- Wait in the waiting room for a nurse to come
- Walk to a room to have your blood pressure, temperature and oxygen measured
- Change into hospital pajamas. They might look like this!



- Next you will walk with your parents to where the MRI camera is, and wait. The waiting room looks something like this.



- When your team is all ready, a nurse will come to get you and one of your parents.
- You will lie on our bed; your parent will still be with you!
- A doctor will help hold a pink mask over your nose and you can take big deep breaths. The mask looks like this! Some kids say it smells like cherries.



- This medicine will make you feel very tired, but after waking up you can have some juice and go home!
- You may also have a straw called an IV on your hand. When you wake up and have a drink, the nurse will take it off.
